

Problems seeing your dashboard at night?

A common problem on ford capris is the dimly lit dashboard at night, a lot of people fit white dial kits to try to cure the problem but end up with poor results. This problem can be banished forever at no cost to you except your time.

Firstly remove the steering wheel and indicator stalks.

Unscrew and remove the lower dashboard covers. (14x screws)

Remove radio (method of removal will depend on the radio fitted)

Remove dash fascia panel (3x screws at bottom of dash)

Unscrew and remove the white gauge mounting plate from the car (4 x screws), make sure you undo the oil gauge pipe first using a 14mm spanner.

Now unscrew the gauges from their white mounting plate, note carefully where each one goes! Do not loose any components or they will not work when you refit them.

You will see a set of blue domes under which is a lamp, remove the blue domes, most of the time these will crack and break off in your hand. Bin them.

Now carefully reassemble the gauges back to their positions on the white mounting plate. Refit dash in reverse order of above. Now wait til dark and try your lights!

Much better!
